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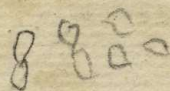


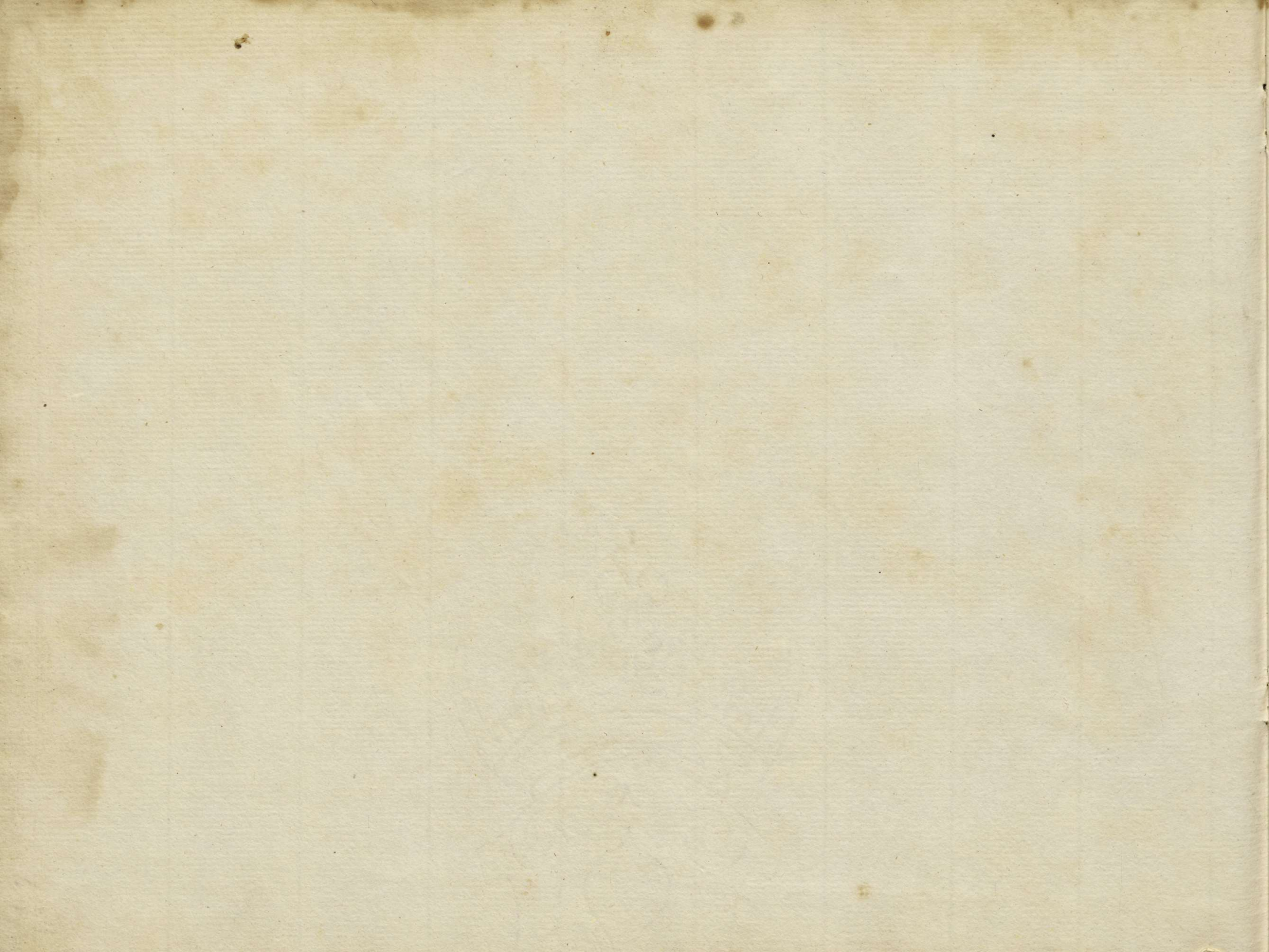
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News - An Order was issued that no British sh. be sold without a
previous permission obtained from the Lt. Governor - A Hopla having a small

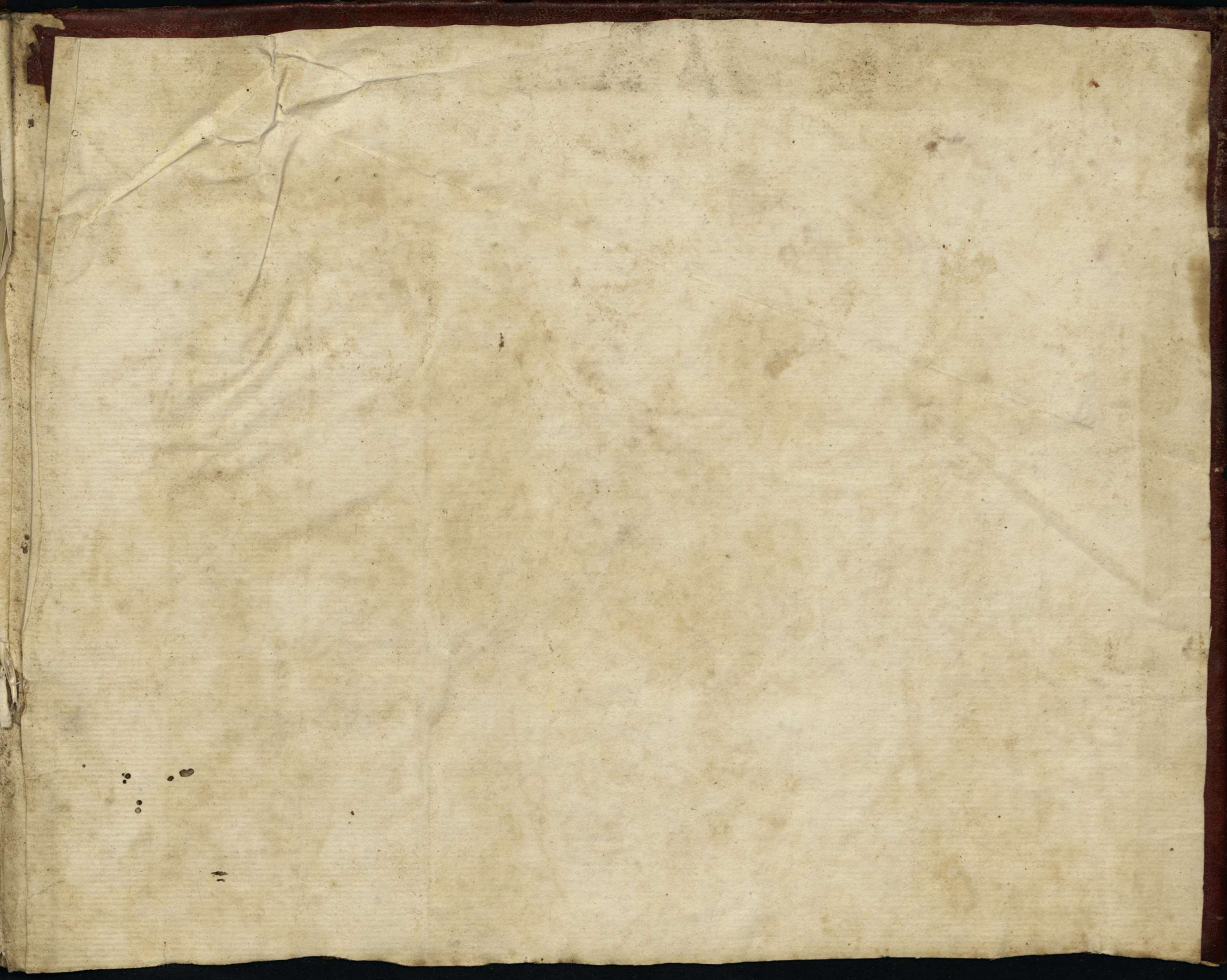
